The Michigan Association of Mayors Board of Directors is looking for nominations for the Annual Advocate of the Year Award. **Nominations for this award are open to any Michigan Association of Mayors member who has shown exemplary work in advocating for cities, villages, and urban townships at either the state or local level.** A complete list of MAM members can be found at michiganmayors.org. Nominations will be reviewed and a winner will be selected by the MAM Board of Directors. The recipient of this award will be presented with a plaque at the MAM Annual Business meeting during the Michigan Municipal League's Annual Convention in the fall. Nominations should be turned in **no later than Friday, August 17, 2018** in order to be considered.

Nomination Criteria:

1. The individual must be a Mayor, Village President, or Township Supervisor who is a member of the Michigan Association of Mayors.
2. The outstanding advocacy work shall benefit cities, villages, and urban townships at either the state or local level, and their work must exemplify the role of being a chief elected official for the community's residents.
3. This work must have been exemplified during the last 12 months, not over the individual's lifetime.
4. No self nominations please.
